

Social Committee Charter

Mission Statement:

The Social Committee is in charge of enhancing the social experience for the Kedma community by providing them with multiple events (both large and small) to bring the community together.

The Committee:

1. The Committee Chair and the general Social Committee members lead the Social Committee. Membership is governed as follows:
 - a. Membership and Eligibility
 - i. Any member of the Kedma Community is eligible to be part of the General Social Committee
 - ii. Members can join via walk on until there are 7 members. After that, it is an application process.
 - iii. A majority vote is needed to approve a new member.
 - iv. Once the committee reaches 10, excluding the chair, the committee is closed to new members.
 - v. Community members may join or apply to the Committee at any time.

Member Rights and Responsibilities:

1. Help come up with creative events that the Kedma Community will enjoy
2. Help set and clean up after an event
3. Attend an event that the Social Committee is running
 - a. If a Committee Member can't make the event they must email the Chair of the Social Committee with a reason why they can't attend
4. Promoting events on various social media sites and word of mouth.

The Committee Chair

1. Responsibilities:
 - a. To lead and hold meetings with committee members to keep them informed of the events and how they are going to run
 - b. To make sure the event runs smoothly
 - c. To be the intermediary between the Kedma board and the committee
 - d. To do the behind the scenes work of the event:
 - i. Rent space
 - ii. Meet with various members that take part in making the event happen
 - iii. Create events on Facebook
2. Election of Committee Chair
 - a. Only a current member of the Social Committee may run for the Committee Chair.
 - b. The term is one full year beginning at the end of the fall semester.
 - c. If no one in the Social Committee wants to run for Chair, then anyone in the Kedma Community may run for the Chair.
 - d. There is no limit on the amount of times a person can hold the position of Chair

- e. The Chair can be voted out of office by a majority of the Committee.
- f. If only 1 person wants to run for Committee Chair, then no vote is needed, and that Committee Member becomes Committee Chair. In the event that two or more Committee Members want to run for the chair, then the non-running Committee Members will vote to elect the next Chair.
